## Camden to get funds for housing

The city's housing authority will receive \$10 million in federal stimulus funds to help complete its Roosevelt Manor project in the Centerville neighborhood.

The aid will be used "to leverage the additional funding" needed to build an additional 64 homes at the site, U.S. Sen. Robert Menendez, D-NJ, said Tuesday.

The project will replace a now-demolished public housing complex.

The Camden authority also will get \$1 million to improve Kennedy Towers, a senior-citizen complex in East Camden.
