



HACC to Utilize Stimulus Funding for Capital Improvements & Creation of Jobs

CAMDEN, NJ – The Housing Authority of the City of Camden has been informed by the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development that it has received \$4.2 million in stimulus funding for capital improvements, through the American Recovery & Reinvestment Act (ARRA) that was approved by Congress and signed by the President.

The HACC has allowed for the 10 day public comment period for amendments to the Annual and Five (5) Year Plan as required by HUD in April 2009. At special meeting of the Board of Commissioners held in April 2009 the amendments were approved.

The HACC has elected to use Force Account for some of the projects which will create jobs for residents of public housing and Camden City.

Work planned, pending actual costs are:

- **23 Unit Rehabilitation**
 - C.T. Branch Village (13 units)
 - W.S. Ablett Village (10 units)
- **Roof Replacements for 26 buildings**
 - Mickle Tower (1 roof)
 - Westfield Tower (1 roof)
 - W.S. Ablett Village (24 roofs)
- **Replacements of Windows, Entry & Screen Doors**
 - W.S. Ablett Village
- **Additional Parking Lots**
 - Kennedy Tower
 - Westfield Tower
